U.S. Embassy in Belize Consular Section
Closed for Administrative Business

The Consular Section of the U.S. Embassy in Belize will be closed the entire day on Friday, November 13, 2009 for administrative business.

No visa or American citizen services will be available. For emergencies on this day before 5:00pm involving the death, incarceration, injury, or hospitalization of American Citizens please call the general Embassy line at 822-4011 and ask to speak to a staff member from the Consular Section. For emergencies after 5:00pm, please telephone our duty officer at 610-5030.

Reminder

American Citizens Services Appointments

The American Citizens Services Unit of the Embassy of the United States now has timed appointments for services on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

If you plan to come to the Embassy for services on a Tuesday or Wednesday, you must first make an appointment for the following:

- Passports: First Time, Renewals, and Additional Visa Pages
- Consular Reports of Birth Abroad
- Notaries and Other Legal Services

To make an appointment, customers will need to logon to our website at http://belize.usembassy.gov/citizen_services.html, and follow the links—providing information as needed based on the service being requested.

Other Service Days

Please remember Thursdays are an administrative day for the Unit. We do not provide services, except for emergencies to the public. Mondays (8:00am to 11:00am; 1:00pm to 4:00pm) and Friday mornings (8:00am to 11:00am) are currently *drop-in* service hours for customers unable to make an appointment, as well as for all Social Security and other Federal Benefits Assistance.

Emergencies

For emergencies involving death, incarceration, injury or hospitalization, American Citizens can drop in at any time before 5:00pm and can telephone our emergency duty officer after 5:00pm at 610-5030.
